

This status indicates that your organisation demonstrated the ability to comply with Ford's R&M expectations. It is expected that Dürr's capabilities, and commitment to this process, will continue in the development of the remaining Ecoclean Group companies.

Understand that this is a tremendous responsibility, each company must commit to receiving guidance and coaching as well as implementing the R&M processes demonstrated at Dürr Automation. Should the European based companies fail to embrace this process, and follow this direction, they will be reduced to Red Status, and expected to obtain Ford R&M Green Status as independent companies. Companies not having Green Status in R&M will not be sourced for business beginning 2003.

Ms. Stadler, of the Dürr Automation Quality Office, has demonstrated a clear understanding of Ford's R&M expectations. I would strongly suggest your efforts to bring the entire organization to the required level of R&M implementation include Ms. Stadler's expertise.
